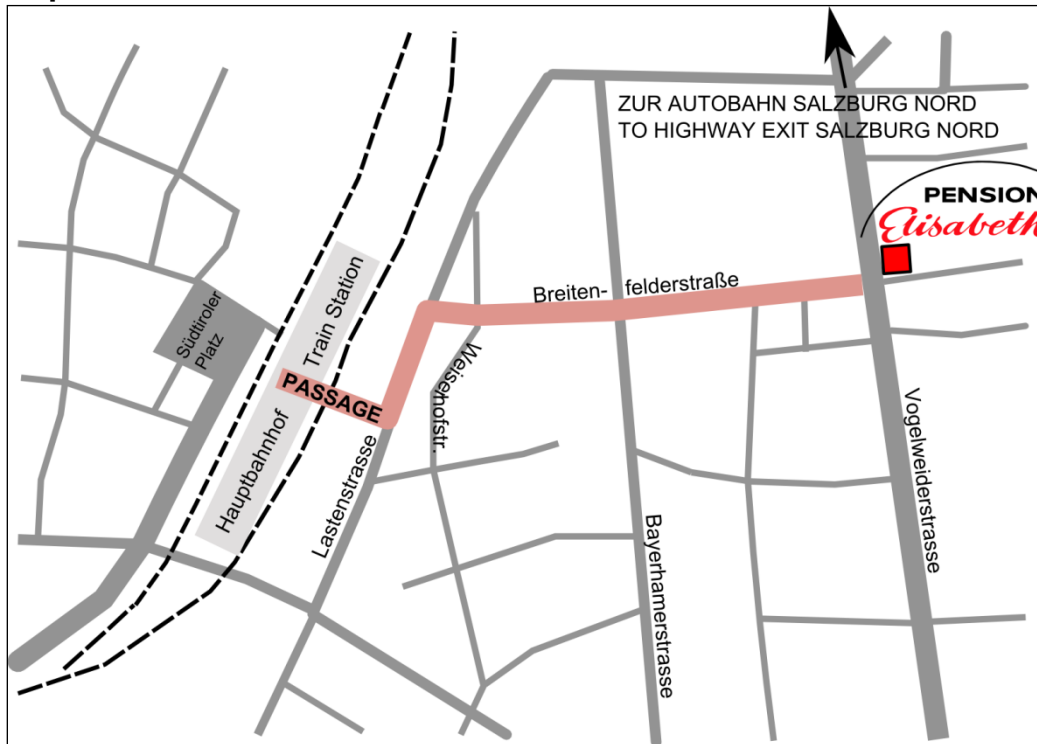


How to arrive at Pension Elisabeth

Arrival by car:

If you are travelling by car you will find us easily. From the Munich - Vienna highway A1, exit at Salzburg - Nord exit, [direction Salzburg](#). You will automatically come on to Vogelweiderstraße, where we are on the left side at the crossing with Breitenfelderstraße.

Parking:

We have a limited supply of our own parking spaces. You are welcome to use these free of charge, but they cannot be reserved. If all our parking spaces are occupied, you can also use the surrounding short-term parking zone free of charge. It is limited to 3 hours parking during the day (insert parking disc!), unlimited between 7 pm and 9 am and on weekends. Please ask at the reception where you can park.

From Salzburg Airport:

There are 3 options for the journey from the airport, one is without changing, but with a 7-minute walk, with the other two you must change once, but arrive directly opposite Pension Elisabeth.

You can buy bus tickets at the Tabak Trafik (kiosk) in Terminal 1 or (more expensive) from the bus driver. In both cases, only cash payment is accepted.

Option 1)

Take bus **line 2** (direction "Obergnigl", the bus stop is directly in front of the airport terminal 1). Get off at the bus stop "**Vogelweiderstraße**" and **walk** from there to us (approx. [7 minutes](#)): After getting off the bus, you need to walk a few metres back to the last set of traffic lights that the bus has passed. At this junction, please turn right and follow the road (you are already on Vogelweiderstraße, where we are located) straight ahead until the next set of traffic lights. There we are, not hard to find. The journey takes about 30 minutes.

Option 2)

Or you can take **bus no. 2** as above but get off at the "**Mirabellplatz**" stop in the centre and wait there, at the same stop, for **bus no. 21**. Bus no. 21 will take you directly to us: get off at the "**Breitenfelderstraße**" stop, which is the fifth stop after Mirabellplatz, we are just diagonally opposite at the traffic lights. The journey time from the airport to Mirabellplatz is approx. 25 minutes, and 7 minutes from Mirabellplatz to Pension Elisabeth, although you may have to wait a few minutes when changing buses.

Option 3)

From the airport, take **line 10** (in the direction of Sam or Lankessiedlung) to the "**F. Hanusch Platz**" stop, then **change to line 21** (in the direction of Bergheim or Lengfelden). Get off at the stop "**Breitenfelderstraße**", diagonally opposite us. The journey time is about the same as for option 2), the route is a little nicer (you can get a first impression of the old town here) and less busy. Line 10 runs less frequently though.

Arrival by train

Walking directions from Salzburg Hauptbahnhof (main train station):

We can be reached from the train station in [ten minutes](#) on foot.

- 1) Having arrived in Salzburg, do NOT walk out of the train station through the main hall (so NOT towards "Südtiroler Platz"). Instead, please **follow the signs pointing to "Schallmoos"**, leading you through the underground passage and to the East exit of the train station.



- 2) At the end of the underground passage please use the stairs to the left (of course you may also use the elevator), leading to the street named "Lastenstraße"



- 3) Please cross the street, walk a few meters to the left and then turn right, into the car park of a 6-storied apartment building in pale red.



- 4) Please cross the parking lot (past the barrier for cars). After the parking lot, please cross the street and follow the street straight ahead named "Breitenfelderstraße".



- 5) You will arrive at another small crossing. Please continue straight ahead, still following "Breitenfelderstraße", past a bike shop and past "Norma" supermarket. At the next crossing with traffic lights you find Pension Elisabeth!



- 6) To make the pedestrian light turn green, please push the button.



- 7) There you are, finally arrived at Pension Elisabeth!



If you prefer taking a bus from the train station to Pension Elisabeth:

Option 1)

Take the **regional bus 120 or 121** from [bus terminal A](#) at Südtirolerplatz in the direction of Mattsee. It only takes 10 minutes to get to our bus stop "**Salzburg Breitenfelderstraße**" on this bus line, but these buses run less frequently - approx. every half hour. City bus tickets are also valid on regional buses as far as the city limits, so they are sufficient for travelling to us.

Option 2)

Leave the station in the direction of Südtiroler Platz, i.e. through the main hall. You will come to a wide square with bus lanes on the left-hand side. All city buses that go to the city centre (**city bus lines 1, 2, 3, 5, 6 and 25**) leave from [bus terminals B and C](#). You can take any of these buses and get off at the "**Mirabellplatz**" stop, which is the third stop after the railway station. On the buses, the upcoming stops are shown on a display and announced by tape. If you wish to stop, you must press one of the many stop request buttons in good time. If you have taken bus number 1, 3, 5, 6 or 25, you have to cross the road at Mirabellplatz in the direction of the "Backwerk" shop on the [corner of Paris-Lodron-Straße](#). This is the stop for buses 2, 4, 21 and 22. If you took bus 2 from the railway station to Mirabellplatz, you are already at the right stop. From here, please **take bus 21** and get off at "**Breitenfelderstraße**", which is the fifth stop from Mirabellplatz. Here we are, diagonally opposite at the traffic lights, barely 30 metres away.

Taking a taxi from the train station: The cheapest way to get to us by taxi is not to go to the taxi stand at Südtirolerplatz, but to the one in Lastenstraße, as taxis have a much shorter route from there.

Bus tickets

Tickets for the city bus are best bought in advance from the tobacconist (kiosk) or from us. They are much cheaper when bought in advance than from the bus driver. There are single ride tickets (transfer possible in the forward direction), 24-hour tickets (any number of journeys in the entire city area, from validation until the same time the next day), weekly tickets, monthly tickets, reduced tickets for children and senior citizens, as well as offers for groups and families.

There is a tobacconist selling all types of bus tickets at both the railway station and the airport, as well as near Pension Elisabeth. You can buy single ride tickets and 24-hour tickets at our reception.

Please note that most ticket sales points only accept cash.

SalzburgCARD:
